

Emergency Accommodation Documentation

Students with Transitory Impairments

Students experiencing transitory impairments, as designated by the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act of 2008 (effective January 1, 2009), are impaired with an actual or expected duration of 6 months or less.

Students who are identified with a transitory impairment may receive testing accommodations from Table 2 of the *Participation Guidelines*. The need for accommodations must be made by a school committee and documented prior to testing. Copies of this documentation must be kept at the school or district. Decisions are made on a case-by-case basis dependent on the needs of the student and the construct measured on the assessment. Students with a transitory impairment are not eligible to participate in the Alternative Assessment Program (Modified HSGQE and Nonstandardized HSGQE).
